## **HOW TO OBTAIN A RESIDENTIAL PERMIT:**

- 1. EFFECTIVE July 1, 2009: <u>Subdivisions</u> that received Final Plat approval after March 10, 2003, are required to provide a Tennessee Department of Conservation and Environment (TDEC) Notice of Coverage (NOC), in order to obtain a Montgomery County residential building permit for each lot in that subdivision. ALL subdivisions must maintain a TDEC NOC until all construction conducted in the subdivision in complete. An NOC can be obtained from TDEC by following the instructions on the TDEC Website: <a href="http://tennessee.gov/environment/permits/conststrm.shtml">http://tennessee.gov/environment/permits/conststrm.shtml</a>.
- 2. A parcel of land that has been subdivided after November 1, 1995 will require one of the following:
  - Current Survey map of parcels to be built on meeting current residential standards for <u>5 acres</u> or <u>more</u> shall be required.

OR

Minor Plat of a parcel will be required for property that is <u>less than 5 acres</u> and the parcel is not in a platted subdivision. This plat must be recorded at the Register of Deed's office. The Regional Planning Commission 329 Main Street, Clarksville, TN 37040 Phone 931-645-7448. Most surveyors' offices have the information for the minor plat process. Once the process has been completed, this office will need a copy of the recorded minor plat before a building permit will be issued.

The process in obtaining a miner plat is as follows, but may not be limited to:

- Obtain an engineer/surveyor, we suggest that you request to have the surveyor supply you with 15-20 copies
- Make application with the Regional Planning Commission for review, verification/corrections to the plat before proceeding to get signatures (For fees assessed to this application please contact the Regional Planning Commission)
- Hire/obtain a soil consultant for soil mapping
- Obtain all signatures to complete the miner plat, including the final signature at the Regional Planning Commission
- Record at the Register of Deeds

\*\*NOTE: Completion of a Minor Plat will require all signature blocks to be completed, returned to the RPC for final signature and approval of plat and shall be recorded at the Register of Deeds.

- 3. Montgomery County Control Map, Group, and Parcel ID shall be obtained from the Assessor of Property.
  - Septic Tank Permit: This office requires a copy of the septic tank permit. Once installed, a copy of the Certificate of Completion will need to be provided. Septic tank permits are obtained thru the State Department Environment and Conservation Division of Ground Water Protection online at <a href="https://tdec.tn.gov/septic">https://tdec.tn.gov/septic</a> or 615-687-7000. Lots 5 acres or less created after 1973 are required to have a current survey and 2 soil maps to include the lot it was broken off from.
  - Lots 5 acres or less created November 1, 1995 shall complete Minor Plat process listed in item 1.

- 4. Culvert/Road Damage Bond: This office requires a copy of the Culvert/Road Damage Bond (issued by the Montgomery County Highway Department); this may be obtained at the time the minor plat is being signed or prior to obtaining the building permit. Contact the Montgomery County Highway Department, 1213 Highway Dr.; Clarksville, TN 37040, 931-648-5740 \*\*NOTE: This office is closed every Friday.
  - If the road frontage is located on a State Highway this office requires a letter issued by TDOT. Contact TDOT 1918 Wilma Rudolph Blvd., Clarksville, TN 37040 931-648-5570
- **5. Street Address**: If in an established subdivision, the Regional Planning Commission will supply this office an address sheet with the addresses assigned to each lot, however the address(s) for a minor plat may be requested at the time the last signature block is signed at the RPC.
- 6. Adequate Facilities Tax: A copy of the Adequate Facilities Tax (AFT) receipt is required at this office. The Adequate Facilities Tax is paid at Register of Deed's for the <u>lot portions only which are less than 5 acres</u>, when recording the plat. The dwelling portion <u>AND</u> lots over 5 acres will be paid here, at the Montgomery County Building & Codes Department.

\*\*All steps <u>shall</u> be completed in order to obtain a building permit; <u>however additional steps may also</u> <u>be required which we are unaware of at the time application is made.</u>

## Permit Fee Schedule:

- \$.38 Per square foot for new construction, additions, accessory buildings, and single wide mobile homes to include double wide mobile homes.
- \$105.00 each for Plumbing and HVAC permit
- ALL permits are subject to a \$5.00 archive and records fee
