All Juvenile Court Petitions or citations which charge a juvenile with being delinquent or unruly, must be sworn to in the presence of one of the following pending further orders of this court:

- 1. Juvenile Court Judge;
- 2. Juvenile Court Deputy Clerk;
- 3. Magistrates of the Montgomery County Sherriff's Department

If the juvenile is eleven (11) years or younger, and charged with a delinquent offense, the Petition or citation must be sworn to in the presence of a duly elected Juvenile Court Judge. If the 11 year old is charged with truancy or unruly, the above listed persons may also sign those Petitions.

Further, all Petitions electronically signed, i.e. *docusign*, must be returned to the Juvenile Court Clerk's office within 24 hours or the next business day for filing.
