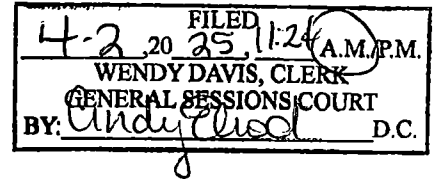






ORDER REGARDING PROCEDURE FOR VIOLATION OF CONDITIONS OF
RELEASE REQUIRING AN GPS MONITORING SYSTEM PURSUANT
TO T.C.A. 40-11-150

Effective March 24th , 2025 the following shall be incorporated into the
Local Rules of Practice for the General Sessions Court for Montgomery
County, Tennessee

If a defendant fails to pay for the costs associated with operating the defendant's GPS monitoring system, or costs of providing the complaining witness with a cellular device application or receptor as required by statute, the qualified service provider of the defendant shall notify the Court in writing within five (5) days of the arrearage. The Court shall then schedule a show cause hearing within ten (10) days of the qualified service provider's notice to the Court. At the show cause hearing, At the show cause hearing the Court may, revoke the defendant bond and incarcerate the defendant, allow the defendant to immediately cure the deficiency and allow the defendant to remain on release.
