CLARIFYING THE ROLES BETWEEN COUNTY AND CITY GOVERNMENTS

## County

The Montgomery County Election Commission promotes voter registration and the electoral process, to secure the freedom and purity of the ballot, to provide federal, state, and local election products and services to the citizens of Clarksville-Montgomery County.

Requirements to register to vote in Tennessee, you must register to vote thirty (30) days prior to any election to vote in that election.

To become a registered voter you must meet the following requirements:

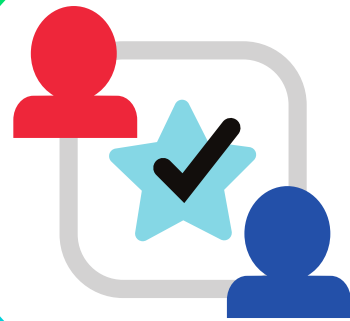
- Be at least 18 years old on or before election day;
- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Be a resident of the state of Tennessee (Guidelines for Determining Residency); and
- Not have been convicted of a felony; or, if you have been convicted of a felony, you must have had your voting rights restored (Restoration of Voting Rights).
- Go in person to the Election Commission Office at 350 Pageant Lane, Suite 404, Clarksville, TN 37040
- By mail or online through the Tennessee State website at [govotetn.com](http://govotetn.com).
