Highway Department:

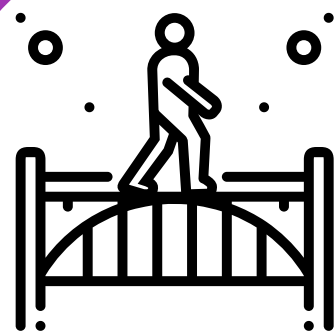
The Montgomery County Highway Department provides citizens of Montgomery County with a safe, affordable transportation system that ensures the mobility of people, products and promotes economic prosperity while preserving the quality of the environment.

Constructs, maintains, and repairs all of the *County-owned* roads and bridges encompassing the 758 miles of the County road system.

Fully serviced with a vehicle maintenance sign shop, road striping, paving, mowing, and construction equipment.

The department has a wide range of responsibilities including mowing all county rights-of-way, salting County roads and bridges, snow and debris removal, bridge and road construction, striping, etc.

The department also constructed and maintains the Lock B North and Lock B South boat ramps.

Street Department:

The Clarksville Street Department provides Clarksville citizens with quality, well maintained, and congestion-free roadway infrastructure, while providing resources and engineering support for the stormwater drainage system.

Core Areas

- Drainage maintenance
- Road maintenance
- Traffic control and engineering
- Continue multiyear pavement management program
- Repair remaining sidewalks in poor condition

Draining Maintenance

- Inspect all high priority drainage assets every quarter
- Resolve all level I and level II drainage complaints by stormwater ordinance

Traffic Control & Engineering

- Implement citywide closed loop signal system
- Implement stormwater processes by National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System
- Maintains and updates the current inventory of all infrastructure assets for Governmental Accounting Standards.
