The mission of MCVSO is to advise veterans and their eligible dependents of all benefits to which they may be entitled and to assist them in filing claims to obtain those benefits. MCVSO provides all services at absolutely no cost.

The doors to MCVSO are open to any veteran who needs assistance, regardless of where they live.

The VSO is made up of a team of veteran service officers who are employed by the Montgomery County Government and trained and certified through the Tennessee Department of Veterans Services.

The VSO assists veterans in navigating the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs system in applying for a variety of veterans benefits and entitlements, to include:

- Disability Compensation
- Veterans Non-Service Connected Pension
- Survivor Benefits to include DIC & Pension
- Healthcare
- GI Bill and other Education benefits
- Vocational Rehabilitation
- Appeals
- Military Service and Discharge Records
