

# Court Services - Adult Probation

CLARIFYING THE ROLES BETWEEN  
COUNTY AND CITY GOVERNMENTS

## County

### Adult Probation -

Adult Court Services has three divisions of service that enforce the orders of the General Sessions Court by providing misdemeanor offenders timely and efficient supervision, intervention and treatment services that promote public safety and accountability. The department seeks to reduce the rate of recidivism.

### Adult Probation Services -

Provide supervision services to defendants to fulfill orders of the court within the probationary period. On average, 1,200 misdemeanor probationers are under supervision per month. The department also collects fines, costs, fees, and restitution. Services also include case management, case coordination with other states and counties, drug testing, community referrals, and job readiness classes.

### Intervention Services -

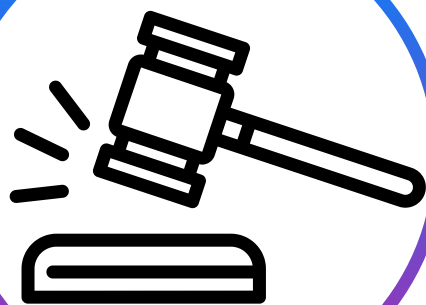
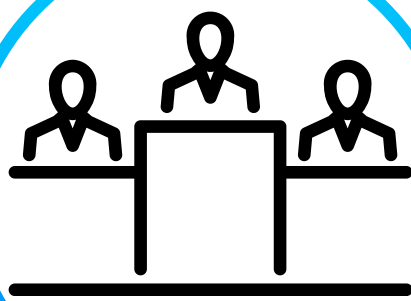
Facilitators provide education and group intervention services to program participants to fulfill their court order and learn to live a life free of criminal behavior.

### Adult Court-

The Recovery Court Program provides intense supervision, treatment referral and job placement services so participants can recover from addiction, remain drug free, and reduce costs associated with incarceration. Consists of four phases of progression over 15-18 months. Drug Court collaborates with community partners for services to recovery court participants and their families. The recovery court team is a multi-disciplinary team committed to a non-adversarial approach to intervention.
