CDE Lightband:

CDE Lightband offers electric, television, Internet and phone service in the city limits of Clarksville. CDE Lightband is the municipal power provider and serves over 72,000 metered homes and businesses with electric service and over 22,000 customers with broadband services.

Though a City department, is generally guided by a governing board.

Gas & Water:

Clarksville Gas and Water delivers natural gas, water, and wastewater services to citizens in the City of Clarksville, Tennessee, and the Montgomery County service area.

Natural gas service is also provided to Robertson and Cheatham counties in Tennessee, Christian and Todd counties in Kentucky, and the Fort Campbell, Kentucky military installation.

Though a City department, is generally guided by an advisory board.

CEMC

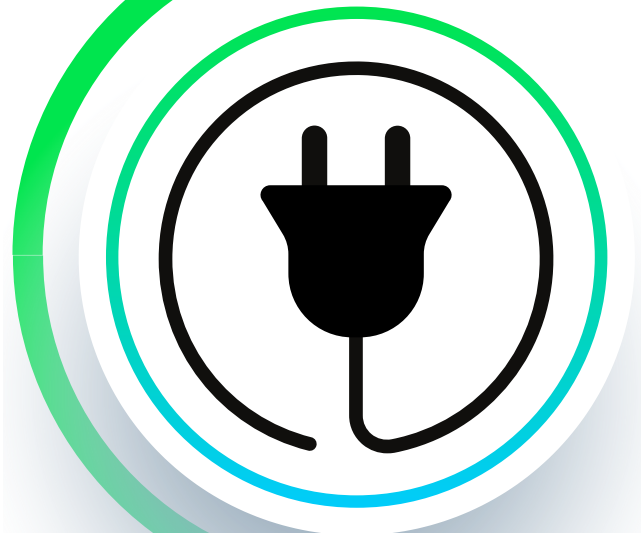
Cumberland Electrical Membership Corporation:

CEMC is a private power distributor in a growing five-county area in Tennessee, serving Cheatham, Montgomery, Robertson, Stewart, and Sumner counties.

They are a nonprofit electric cooperative regulated by TVA and governed by a member elected board of directors.

The Cooperative's members elect a Board of Directors to represent them in setting policy, approving the budget, and overseeing the strategic direction of the cooperative.

CEMC Cumberland Connect has fiber services available for their customers.
