

ELECTION NOTICE

A State Primary (Republican and Democratic) and a County General Election is hereby called for Montgomery County, Tennessee for Thursday, August 2, 2012 between the hours of 7:00 am and 7:00 pm at the various precincts to elect the following:

STATE PRIMARY

US Senate, US Representative, TN State Senate
TN State House of Representatives (District 67, 68 & 74)

COUNTY GENERAL

Assessor of Property, Highway Supervisor***
School Board (School Districts 2, 4, 6)***

*** Additional qualifying papers required as follows:

Highway Supervisor candidates must file affidavit and other evidence of their qualifications and standards required with the Tennessee Highway Officials Certification Board not later than fourteen (14) days prior to the qualifying deadline. Highway Supervisor deadline at Tennessee Highway Officials Certification Board is March 22, 2012 to file affidavit.

School Board candidates must file proof of high school graduation or proof of GED by the qualifying deadline.

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: April 5, 2012 at 12:00 NOON

To qualify, candidates shall file their original petition in the county election office where they reside and a certified duplicate petition in any county within their district by the qualifying deadline. The nominating petition must be signed by at least twenty-five (25) voters who are registered in the candidate's district. Each voter who signs the petition must also supply his or her residence address.

Petitions are being issued at the county election office during normal office hours listed below. Any person interested in running for office should contact the Montgomery County Election Commission Office for further information.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: April 12, 2012 at 12:00 NOON

A candidate's request to withdraw must be in writing and filed with each of the counties where the candidate filed their nominating petition.

The last day to register to vote before this election is July 3, 2012.

Pursuant to TCA 2-7-133(i) and TCA 2-8-113(c) notice is hereby given that any person attempting to be elected by write-in ballots or receive a party's nomination by write-in ballots shall complete a notice requesting such person's ballots be counted in each county of the district no later than noon fifty (50) days before the election or primary election. Such person shall only have votes counted in counties where such notice was completed and timely filed. Write-in candidates in elections for the offices of Governor, United States Senate and United States House of Representatives shall file their notice with the state coordinator of elections. The notice shall be on a form prescribed by the coordinator of elections and shall not require signatures of any person other than the write-in candidate requesting ballots be counted. The coordinator of elections shall distribute such form to the county election commissions.

Last Day for Write-in candidate to file notice: June 13, 2012 at Noon. Forms are available in the Montgomery County Election Commission Office.

NEW STATE LAW: Federal or state government issued photo ID is now required to vote, unless an exception applies. College student IDs will not be accepted. To learn more about the new law and its exceptions, go to www.mcgtn.org/election.
