The project was built to replace the old EMS Station 23 that was located along SR 149 near the Hilltop Market that was destroyed by fire. The new 4,331 sq. ft. station boasts a bay area that holds up to four ambulances, sleeping quarters, a full kitchen, a common living area, a tornado safe room, and an office area. This station may also be used as an emergency shelter location with a generator backup available.
