## **ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL COMMITTEE**

**Authority:** TCA 68-8-101 through 68-8-115 et seq. Board of Commissioners Resolution Number 99-11-7, Resolution 15-7-6, and Resolution 19-4-10.

**Purpose:** The purpose of this Committee is to oversee the operation and facilitate and support the tasks performed by the Montgomery County Animal Care and Control Department for and on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners of Montgomery County. The Committee is responsible for drafting and recommending the policies and procedures of the Montgomery County Animal Care and Control Department to the Board of the County Commissioners for approval. The County Mayor will appoint a director who will oversee the day to day tasks of the Department. The purchase of equipment, materials and supplies for the Montgomery County Animal Care and Control Department will be conducted by the Animal Control Director within the budgetary limitations and established operating procedures. The Committee is authorized to review or inspect the ledgers for the purchase of equipment, materials and supplies and may request the Animal Control Director provide the Committee with an update on the day to day activities of the Department at a Committee meeting as deemed appropriate by the Committee.

**Membership:** Total of eight (8) members. Seven (7) members nominated by the County Mayor of Montgomery County with the approval of the Board of Commissioners. One (1) member - County Mayor (or designee) who shall serve as voting member. The committee shall be comprised of the following:

1. Two (2) members of the Montgomery County Commission.
2. One (1) licensed veterinarian who resides within the service area.
3. One (1) member of a recognized humane organization within the service area.
4. One (1) member from the Clarksville Police Department.
5. One (1) member from the Montgomery County Sheriff's Department.
6. One (1) at-large member from within Montgomery County.
7. One (1) County Mayor (or designee), Coterminous.

The Animal Care & Control Director shall serve as an ex-officio member.

**Terms:** Two (2) years on a staggered basis, to expire each January. Appointments shall be made in January. No member shall serve for more than two (2) full two-year terms in succession.

**Meetings:** Bi-Monthly or at the call of the chairman of the committee or a majority of the members of the committee.

**Compensation:** As specified in Section I.
