County Mayor Appointments; 6-year term w/o succession

BI-COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

Authority: TCA 68-211-904, Resolution of the Committee on Committees dated September 14, 1998 and Resolution 19-1-10

Purpose: The board shall have general supervision of the solid waste disposal system in both Stewart and Montgomery Counties. The board shall also have (I) general supervision and control of the employment of clerical, management and supervisory, and all other personnel necessary and incident to the full and complete administration of the solid waste disposal system and (II) the general supervision and control of landfill sites, solid waste collection stations and transfer stations, and all material and equipment, in connection with the system herein provided for.

Membership: Seven (7) members. Four (4) of whom shall be nominated by the County Mayor of Montgomery County subject to confirmation by the Board of Commissioners of Montgomery County. Two of the four members shall be members of the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners; one (1) member nominated by the County Mayor of Stewart County subject to confirmation by the Board of Commissioners of Stewart County, and the remaining two (2) members being the County Mayor of Montgomery County and the County Mayor of Stewart County.

Terms: The appointed members shall be appointed for a term of six (6) years by the county mayors of the respective counties, subject to confirmation. The appointed members shall not serve more than one full six-year term.

Meetings: At least once a month at such times and places as the Board may determine. Special meetings may be held upon call by the chairman or by any two members upon appropriate notice.

Compensation: The appointed members shall receive compensation for attending meetings as specified in Section I, provided that no appointed member shall receive compensation for more than twelve (12) attended meetings in any fiscal year. There will be no compensation for called or special meetings. The County Mayors shall receive no compensation for attending any meetings of the board.
