COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ADVISORY BOARD MONTGOMERY AND ROBERTSON COUNTIES

Authority: Laws of the State of Tennessee, TCA 40-36-101 et al., and as required by the Community Corrections Act of 1985; and Resolution 19-1-10 and 19-1-11

Purpose: To make policy and monitor the Montgomery/Robertson County Community Corrections Program, which is an alternative sentencing program serving Montgomery and Robertson Counties.

Membership: Thirteen (13) members to include the following:

- a. County Commissioner – Montgomery County
- b. County Commissioner – Robertson County
- c. Sheriff – Montgomery County
- d. Sheriff – Robertson County
- e. District Attorney – 19th Judicial District
- f. Defense Attorney
- g. State Parole Officer – Clarksville Officer
- h. State Probation Officer – Clarksville Officer
- i. Representative from a non-profit human service agency from each county
- j. 3 private citizens selected from various cross-sections of the two counties

All appointments to the board (other than constitutional elected officials) shall be nominated by the respective county's County Mayor and confirmed by their board of commissioners. The County Mayors from both counties shall serve as ex officio members of the board.

Terms: The following appointments shall be initially appointed to a term of **three** years and thereafter:

- a. Defense Attorney
- b. Probation Representative
- c. Montgomery County Commission Representative
- d. Robertson County Commission Representative

The following shall be appointed for **two** years:

- a. Private Citizen Representative
- b. Representative from non-profit human service agency
- c. State parole Officer

The Sheriffs and District Attorney shall serve during the terms of office. Vacancies shall be filled in the same nomination and confirmation process as original appointments for any unexpired term. There shall be no term limits on members.

Meetings: Twice a year

Compensation: As specified in Section I (Commissioner only)
