COUNTY HISTORIAN

<u>Authority:</u> TCA 5-18-101. In general. The legislative body of each county shall appoint some person of the county as county historian, who shall serve without compensation and whose duties shall include, but not be limited to, collecting and preserving local and state history, and in doing so, to work with, in such a manner as may mutually be agreed upon, the state historian, the state library and archives and the Tennessee historical commission.

Purpose: To preserve and record the history of Montgomery County.

<u>Membership:</u> The county historian shall be nominated by the nominating committee and approved by the Board of County Commissioners. The position is open to any person who has the ability and demonstrated an interest in performing the duties of county historian. Submit resume to nominating committee chairperson.

<u>Terms:</u> Eight (8) years. The office of county historian needs to have long term continuity. Terms are not limited, however, the county historian may train other interested historians in the functions of county historian.

Meetings: None

<u>Compensation:</u> None. \$1000.00 shall be allowed to the county historian for annual expenses.
