COURT SECURITY COMMITTEE

Authority: TCA 16-2-505 (d), amended; Montgomery County Board of Commissioners Resolution 95-5-9.

Purpose: To review security needs in every courtroom and consider minimum security standards as adopted by the Tennessee Judicial Conference in determining court security needs.

Membership: Five (5) members. The committee shall be composed of the County Mayor, Sheriff, District Attorney General, the Presiding Judge of the Judicial District, and a court clerk from the county to be designated by the presiding judge.

Terms: Coterminal with officials' terms of office.

Meetings: At least annually. No later than May 15, each year, the court security committee shall report their findings to the county legislative body and the administrative office of the courts.
