Nominating Committee; 2 year term

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Authority: Recommendation of the Committee on Committees dated September 8, 1997; Resolution of the Committee on Committees dated September 14, 1998; Resolution of the Rules Committee dated September 10, 2012, Resolution 19-1-10 and Resolution 23-3-10.

Purpose: To receive quarterly reports from a representative of the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and the Juvenile/General Sessions Court. The committee may also make recommendations to the County Mayor and to the Board of County Commissioners with regard to the detention of juveniles.

Membership: Five (5) members consisting of four (4) members from the Board of County Commissioners and the County Mayor. The County Commissioners shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee and approved by the Board of Commissioners. The Sheriff, the Juvenile Court Administrator, Veterans Treatment Court Director, the Public Health Director and the Director of Schools of Clarksville-Montgomery County Schools shall serve as ex officio members.

Terms: Two (2) years. The members from the Board of Commissioners shall not serve for more than one two-year term.

Meetings: Quarterly, or at the call of the chairman or a majority of the members of the committee.

Compensation: As specified in Section I.
