PORT AUTHORITY

<u>Authority</u>: Public Chapter No. 415 of the Private Acts, 1967 (House Bill No. 1126) duly approved pursuant to Resolution No. 4 by the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners.

<u>Purpose</u>: To facilitate transportation in the County of Montgomery, in the State of Tennessee, and to promote the movement and transfer of people, goods and merchandise to, from and through Montgomery County.

<u>Membership</u>: Five (5) members appointed by the County Mayor with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners. Each member must be a legal resident of Montgomery County for at least one year immediately preceding his or her election. Members of the Board of County Commissioners shall not be eligible to serve as a member of the Board of Commissioners of the Port Authority.

<u>Terms</u>: Five (5) years, on a staggered basis of which a member's initial term will expire each year up to five years. After the expiration of a member's initial term, that member shall be eligible to serve a term of five years. The successors for each of the five initial members whose full terms have expired shall be elected for regular terms of five years each. There are no term limits.

Meetings: At least once every four months or at the call of the Chairman.
