SCHOOL LIAISON COMMITTEE

Authority: Resolution of the Montgomery County Quarterly Court at its April term in 1968, Resolution 01-9-1 of the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners re-establishing school board districts, Resolution 02-8-1 establishing districts as recommended by the Committee on Committees, and Resolution 17-1-5 amending the geographical districts as recommended by the Rules Committee, and Resolution 19-1-10

Purpose: To act as liaison between the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners and the Clarksville-Montgomery County Board of Education; to attend meetings of the Board of Education and to keep the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners informed as to the operating progress, problems and needs of the school system and the school program.

Membership: Five (5) members of the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners, nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the Board of Commissioners at the January term meeting from their respective school committee districts.

Terms: Two (2) years on a staggered basis. The terms of the members shall expire each January. No member shall serve for more than one two-year term.

Meetings: The committee shall be represented at all regular and special meetings of the Board of Education and shall hold meetings of its own when called on by the chairman or by a majority of the members of the committee.
