1. Would the County accept a comprehensive size chart and/or size run in lieu of on-site staff fittings? **No, on site fitting is imperative for Class A uniforms to be consistent and conforms to what the individual needs.**
2. Could you share the previous bid tabulation, if available? **The 2024 uniform bid returned with only one bidder. Summitt Uniforms, with a total cost of 1 each on the bid of \$2,168.72.**
3. Thank you for sending out this bid info. Would it be possible to get information/images of the customization needed on the items that require it? Is there an estimate available of annual spending on uniforms? **See attached page for images. Annual spending is approx. \$85,000-95,000.**
4. Line 26:
Is the braid specified for this line item intended to be a rank braid around the sleeve, or a shoulder-draped braid (aiguillette)? **Braid around sleeve. See attached.**
5. Line 28:
Could you please provide a reference photo or specification for the shoulder boards currently used by the department? **See attached.**
6. Line 30:
Could you provide the stitch count and/or digitized embroidery file for the EMT/Paramedic shoulder patch specified? **We do not have a stitch count or digital file for the state certification patches. The individual companies keep that information and do not share it with us. We have only been able to locate the 5.11 Critical Response Pant, and would like to confirm the exact pant required for this line item. **Propper Critical Response pants, men and women in dark navy/khaki, F5285/F5286**
11. Line 48:
There are multiple 24/7 pant options available, including the 24/7 Tactical Ripstop Pant and the 24/7 Original 2.0 Pant. Could you please provide the style number to confirm the desired pant for this line item? **The Original Tactical Pant 2.0, item #2222002**
12. Line 58:
The style number and description provided do not appear to match. The listed style number did not return any results; however, the belt description corresponds closely with style number 59551. Could you please confirm whether the listed style number contains a typographical error? **Typographical error. #59551**
13. Line 59:
Could you provide an example, photo, or additional information regarding these pants? The style number provided, 643869, did not return any results through 5.11, and we would like to verify the intended item. **Typographical error. #64386**
14. Line 72:
Could you provide additional specifications, manufacturer information, style numbers, or examples for the short-sleeve and long-sleeve button-up shirts required under this line item. **We currently us Red Kap #SY50 and SY60 but are open to options that could be tactical/work shirts as long as the color remains consistent with the dark grey/charcoal grey color.**
