



**Creek Rock Bid FY27**

**Addendum #1 dated Tuesday, May 26, 2026**

- 1. What size creek rock is required? Is this compatible with TN river rock? For example, 1/2"-1", 1"-3", 2"-5", or another size range?** Local Creek Rock would generally be the same as riverstone, limestone is not acceptable for this bid. The general size would be 1/2" to 1", however there could be occasional larger stone in the loads.
- 2. Is the rock required to be washed or unwashed?** Creek Rock can be unwashed.
- 3. Is this intended to be decorative round creek/river rock, general drainage rock, or another product?** The stone will not be used as decorative. It will be used as drainage and other fill applications.
- 4. Is there a required gradation, material specification, source requirement, or product submittal requirement?** A sample of the creek rock would need to be provided prior to bid award for review.
- 5. Are alternate sources/products acceptable if they meet the intended use?** No
- 6. What is the estimated annual tonnage for FY27, if known?** Unknown at this point. Depends on the landfill permitting process. The last project used approximately 20,000 tons.
- 7. What is the typical order size per delivery?** If ordered, it would be large amounts. Again, the last application used 20,000 tons delivered in a period of a few weeks. And again, this will all be determined based on when landfill permits are issued.
- 8. May the vendor state a full-truckload minimum delivery quantity?** No
- 9. May the vendor provide price breaks based on quantity delivered at one time, as referenced on the bid form?** Yes
- 10. Should the unit price be a fixed delivered price per ton for the entire July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 period?** Yes
- 11. Is any fuel surcharge or material escalation adjustment allowed during the contract period?** No
- 12. Should pricing exclude sales tax, assuming Montgomery County provides a tax-exemption certificate?** Yes
