



Bid Opportunities

F&M Bank Arena, located in the heart of Clarksville, Tennessee, is proudly owned by Montgomery County. Sabertooth Sports & Entertainment (SS&E) serves as the Operator for venue. The venue's primary tenant is Austin Peay State University men's and women's basketball teams. In addition, the facility's flexible event space hosts sporting events, concerts, rehearsals, banquets, conventions, trade shows and more.

Montgomery County in conjunction with SS&E is seeking participants to bid on the following:

- LED Exterior digital signage turnkey system.
- Bid submissions to include options for signage in (3) three exterior locations attached to F&M Bank Arena (specified below):
 - All bids should include screens that are IP67 outdoor rated with a minimum brightness of 6,000 nits, maximum of 10mm pixel pitch. Must be Gold Wire bonded.
 - Option A1: 9.45' H x 18.9' W LED Screen (2nd & College St Fascia)
 - Option A2: 9.45' H x 18.9' W LED Screen (2nd & College St Fascia)
 - Option B: 12.6' H x 59.79' W LED Screen (1st & Main St Fascia)
 - Option C: 16.8' H x 56.69' W LED Screen (1st & College St Fascia)
- System is to include back-end media processor for digital signage and all LED must be capable of full motion.
- Bid is to be inclusive of all low voltage and electrical work.
- Drawings of F&M Bank Arena can be provided upon request.

The bidding process begins **Monday, September 30, 2024** and bids are due by **2:00 PM CST on Friday, October 18, 2024** (followed by post bid interviews). All questions or requests for drawings must be submitted by **12:00 PM CST on Monday, October 7, 2024**. Responses will be provided by **5:00 PM CST on Thursday, October 10, 2024**.

Equipment Specifications

Specifications for Equipment

- Contractor shall provide a turnkey product.
- Bids should be inclusive of air, water, and land freight costs.
- All LED to be front serviceable with a minimum brightness of 6,000 nits.
- All LED to be Gold Wire Bonded.
- All LED to be minimum 10mm pixel pitch or better.
- Video Frame Rate at minimum 60 frames per second.
- Bid to include 3% spare parts.
- Minimum 2 years parts and labor warranty.
- Minimum 100,000 hour lifetime.
- All LED to be IP67 outdoor rated.
- Novastar or Brompton processing is acceptable. Processing to be installed in facilities' technical operation center.
- Processor must be compatible with HDSDI input.
- Screen should be a minimum resolution of 1080p 59.94.
- Vendor to provide pixel maps and raster for signage.
- Installation, power, and signal to be provided by installer.
- System to include media playback server for all signage.

Bid Form Submission Format

Solicitors will provide a total cost for the base bid and all included options. Project cost details for base bid must include the following at a minimum: all equipment, parts, material, shipping, installation, labor, commissioning, programming, and applicable taxes. Fixtures or equipment that do not require installation are tax exempt, tax exemption form can be provided upon request. Fixtures or equipment that require installation are taxable and should be included in the total bid cost.

Detailed specifications of substituted items to be listed in bid proposal and all product data to be submitted with bid to compare substitutions to specified equipment including included warranties.

Provide a proposed timeline indicating task required and the start and completion dates for each. Expectation is that order placement will commence as soon as possible after the contract is awarded. Please list project timeline in bid documents.

Please state any intent to purchase off statewide, national, or federal contracts.

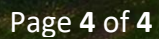

IRAN DIVESTMENT ACT Certification of Non-inclusion
